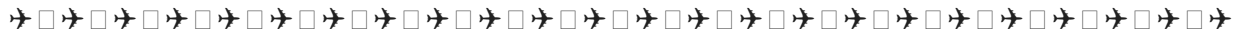

There is still plenty of summer left. Here are some activities you might enjoy.



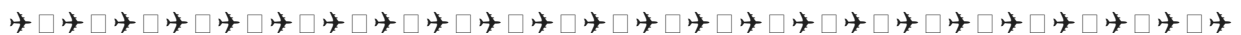
**Saturday, August 19 at 12:00p.m.**

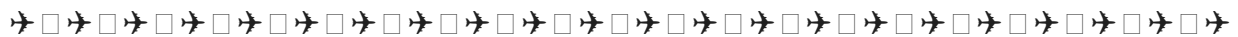
