Winter is still upon us - it is snowing as I write this - but the Ninety-Nines

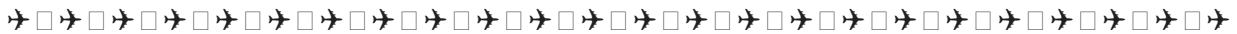
have exciting events coming up in the Spring and Summer! Please join us for these Section and International Meetings.

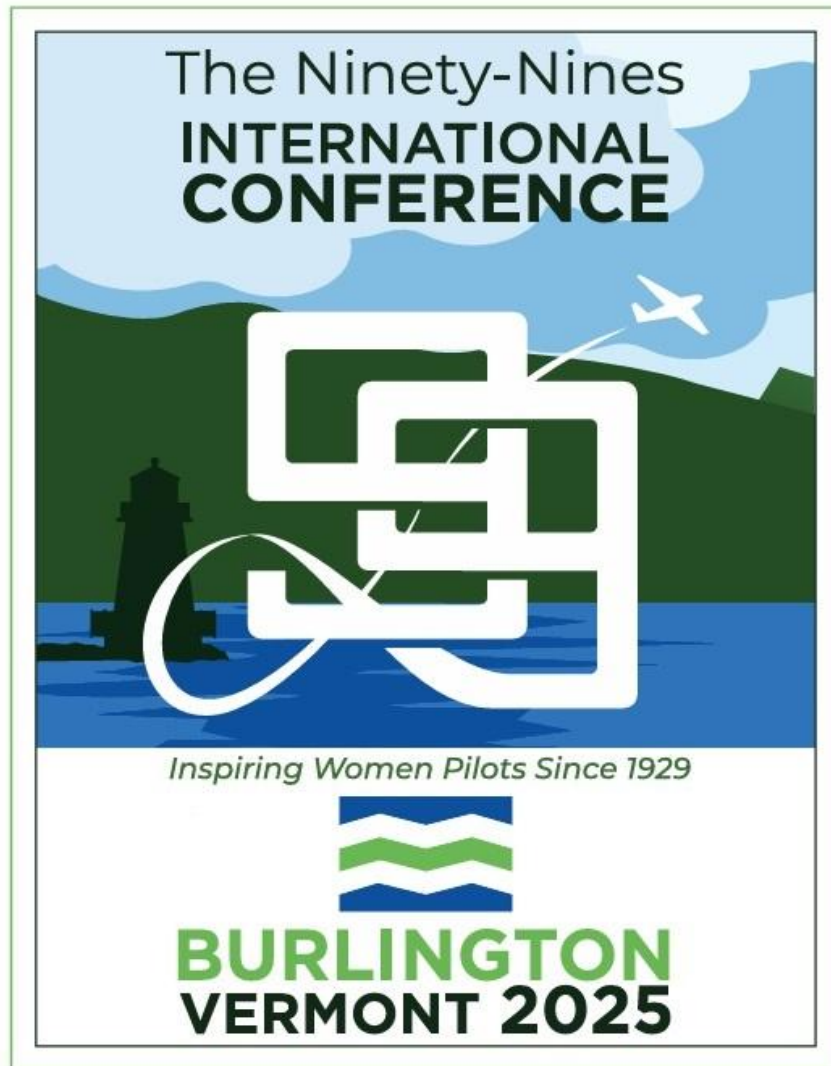

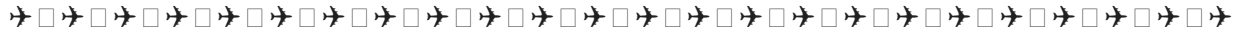




Our New England Section is hosting this year's International Conference! It is in Burlington, Vt. on July 9-13, 2025.
