Professional Pilot Leadership Initiative (PPLI)

The Professional Pilot Leadership Initiative (PPLI) aims to accelerate the advancement of women in aviation professions, facilitate mentoring, and enhance our leadership role in the aviation community. The motivated 99s with the tools to develop their careers and leadership abilities. Through guided activity mentoring partnerships, it strengthens and expands the network of women pilots.

This highly-structured, formal mentoring program is unique. The mentor and mentee will communicate to discuss the mentoring prompts and guided activities. Participants must commit to meeting the mentor for the entire duration of the 18-24 month program.

If you are a 99s member with at least a commercial certificate (and be actively flying) pursuing a professional pilot career, or you are an established professional who wants to take your career to the next level, this program is designed for you.
