

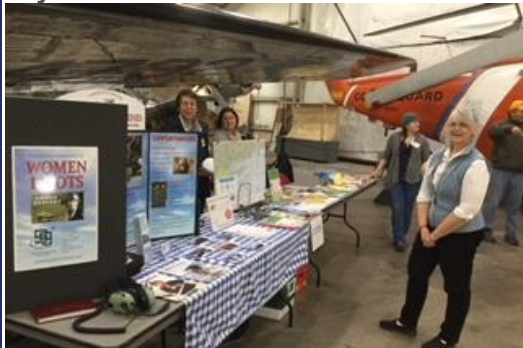


99s: Women Pilots of Eastern New England

We were interviewed for a Veteran's Cable TV station. Hopefully, we will have a link to share when the piece airs.



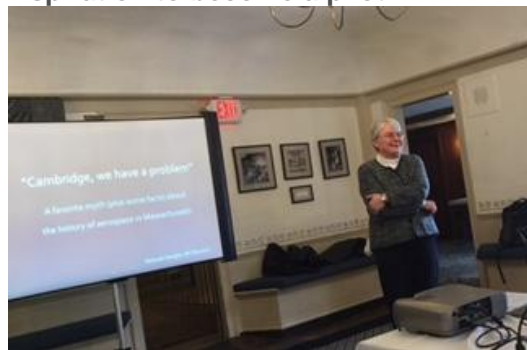
Scholarship Luncheon, March 10
