## \$13,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

### **APPLICATIONS DUE BY DECEMBER 15, 2023**

\$3,000 The ENE 99s Candie Oldham Honorary Scholarship honors a long-time member of our Chapter and is open to a man or woman who has at least soloed.

## \$5,000 The William Bridge Scholarship

is funded by ENE Chapter member Ann Bridge Baddour in memory of her father, and is open to a woman with at least a private pilot certificate who is pursuing an advanced rating.

\$2,000 The Jeanne Ohnemus/ Cynthia Hurvitz Scholarship is open to a woman who is pursuing an advanced rating.

## \$1,000 The ENE 99s Takeoff Scholarship

is funded by an anonymous donation to the chapter. This scholarship is open to a woman who has a student pilot certificate and who has flown at least 4 hours of flight training in the 6 months prior to the application submission.

## \$2,000 The ENE 99s Takeoff Scholarship

is funded by generous donations from ENE Chapter members. This scholarship is open to a woman who has a student pilot certificate and who has flown at least 4 hours of flight training in the 6 months prior to the application submission.

#### Scholarship Requirements

Must be a resident of one of the six New England states who is studying anywhere in the US, or a resident of any state who is studying in one of the New England states.

Candidate must be at least 16 years old and studying in some area of aviation, at a duly accredited school, college flight school, or flight training through an FAA approved flight school or individual flight instructor.

Must have financial need for a scholarship.

Must have a current FAA Medical Certificate or BasicMed.

## 2024 Scholarship Application

Established in 1929, the Ninety-Nines is the oldest international organization of women pilots in the world. In 1931, Amelia Earhart was elected the first President, and the group selected the name "Ninety-Nines" to represent the 99 charter members.

## Scholarships Offered:

- The ENE 99's Candie Oldham Honorary Scholarship (\$3,000) honors a long-time member of the ENE Chapter and is awarded to a man or a woman who has at least soloed.
- The William Bridge Scholarship (\$5,000) is funded by Eastern New England Chapter member Ann Bridge Baddour in memory of her father, and is awarded to a woman with at least a private pilot certificate who is pursuing an advanced rating.
- The Jeanne Ohnemus/Cynthia Hurvitz Scholarship (\$2,000) is open to a woman who is pursuing an advanced rating.
- The ENE 99s Takeoff Scholarship 1 (\$1,000) is funded by an anonymous donation to the chapter. This scholarship is open to a woman who has a student pilot certificate and who has flown at least 4 hours of flight training in the 6 months prior to application submission.
- The ENE 99s Takeoff Scholarship 2 (\$2,000) is funded by generous donations from ENE Chapter members.
  This scholarship is open to a woman who has a student pilot certificate and who has flown at least 4 hours of flight training in the 6 months prior to application submission.

#### Scholarship Requirements

- Must be a resident of one of the six New England states (Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Maine, or Vermont) who is studying anywhere in the US, or a resident of any state who is studying in one of the New England states.
- Candidate must be at least 16 years old and studying in some area of aviation, at a duly accredited school, college flight school, or flight training through an FAA approved flight school or individual flight instructor.
- Must have financial need for the scholarship
- Must have a current FAA Medical Certificate or BasicMed

- > High interest and dedication to aviation as a vocation or an avocation
- Academic or professional achievement
- > Involvement in aviation activities
- Quality of recommendations

### Section 7: Logbook

Submit logbook pages (left and right side logbook pages are required, signed where designated to certify entry) for any flight time completed in the 6 months prior to application.

Application Submission: Only electronic submissions will be accepted. Combine entire application into 1 PDF document prior to submission. Manage file size when attaching photos of documents and compress file prior to submission.
