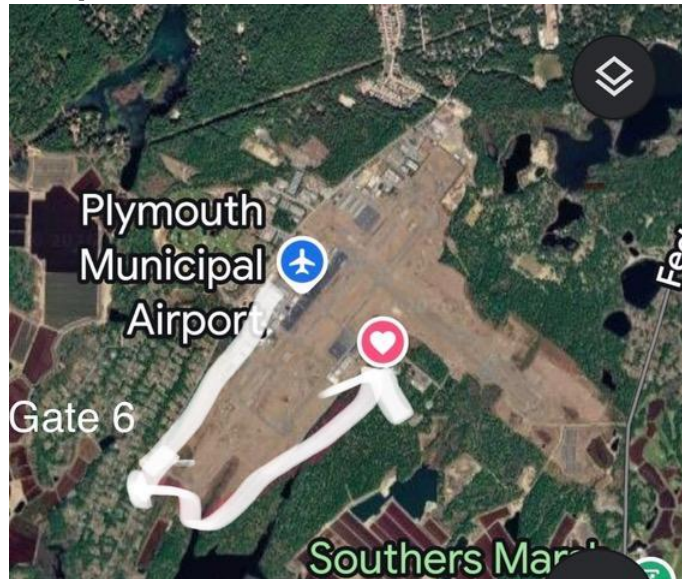
**Lunch at Plane Jane's on airport after the meeting**

The event is **FREE** to Plymouth Aero Club members. Non-members are welcome to participate for the low-low cost of \$20 for two flour bombs. Of course, we need to let you know that membership in the Aero Club is \$20 per year, so you can bomb for free if you renew your membership now!

#### **The Details:**

- **All competitors must fly no lower than 200' AGL.**
- **Pilots must always fly at or above stall speed for the aircraft.**
- **If the field judges deem a flight unsafe, the team will be disqualified.**
- **We can accommodate two teams flying the same aircraft. Please specify in the registration form if you are sharing an aircraft so we schedule the heats appropriately.**
- **We will make the go/no go decision on Saturday prior to the event. If the weather is iffy, we'll hold off as long as possible. If it's clearly going to be perfect (or really awful) we'll make the call earlier. Start praying to the Weather Gods!**
- **Prizes are for first, second & third closest to the barrel. The farthest from the barrel earns the dubious Bug Light Award.**
- **All decisions of the judges are final.**
